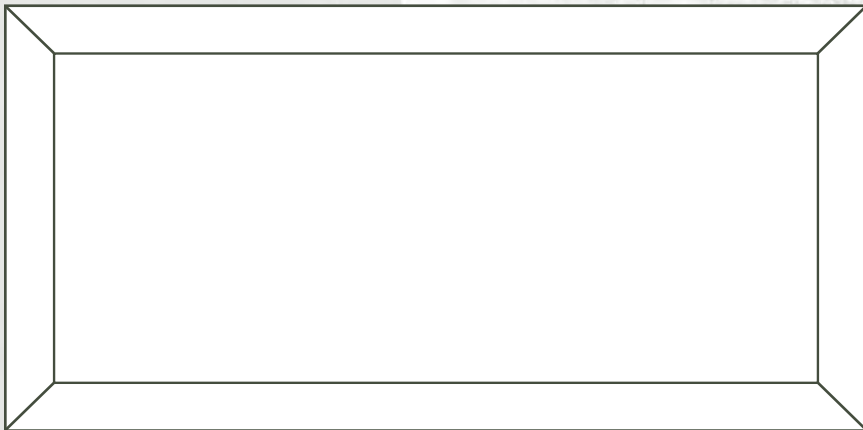


Head Outside to Visit the Maryhill Overlook

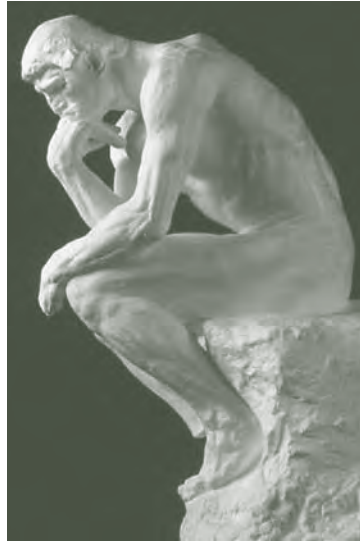

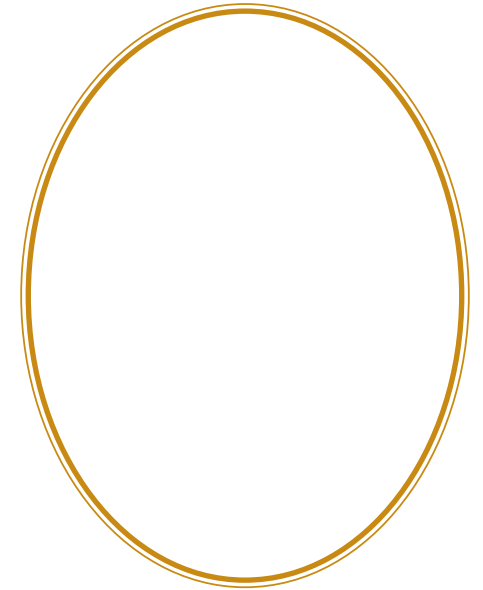
Explore Native American Sculpture
