All prices include sales tax. A 15% gratuity is added for groups.

Getting to Maryhill

Located in Washington on Scenic Route 14 between US 97 and US 197. It may be reached from Oregon by I-84 via The Dalles Bridge on US 197 (Exit 87) or The Sam Hill Memorial Bridge at Biggs Junction at US 97 (Exit 104). It is a two hour drive east of Portland and four hours southeast of Seattle. Overnight accommodations are available. See some drive times, left.
